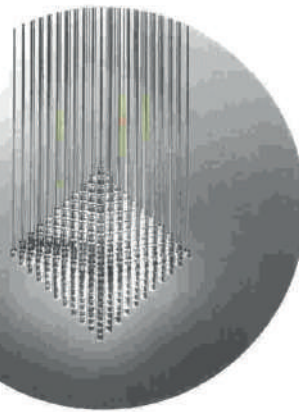

**Wonderglass ▶**

Founded in 2013 by Italian father and son Christian and Maurizio Mussati, Wonderglass is renowned for its roster of international designers. For Maison, the brand paired up with Singaporean architects Woha to design a chandelier for the WOHAbeing collection. Made from glass and bronze, OLI (Sanskrit for 'glow of a lamp') is a modular light that can be stacked, arranged in a pyramid or used as a single element. The light component is a delicate glass bead, fixed to a metal rod, which comes in a concave or convex shape.



**Emu ▶**

Rodolfo Dordoni, Patrick Norguet and Chiamonte/Marin served up the goods for Italian outdoor furniture maestros Emu. But while Dordoni seemed content to reboot his Cross range, Chiamonte/Marin chanced their arm with a towering outdoor floor lamp, Cone, that combined the drama of an Arco lamp with the unlikely aesthetic of a 1950s paper lampshade. There were three other models in the collection: a table lamp, a hanging lamp and a smaller floor lamp. All the products in the Cone range comprise a painted steel structure with a polycarbonate lamp cover with a printed outdoor fabric.



**Minimalux ▶**

London-based, but with its eye on the world, Minimalux's new range of understated yet highly-polished products included a clock, a mirror and Timeless – a watch that is actually a mirror. Yes, what at first glance looks like a super-minimal timepiece does not in reality have any hands. Instead, the watch face is replaced by a disk of mirrored glass to 'check your make up or angle your wrist to secretly scan the room' – presumably to assess whether there is someone cooler to talk to.
